FIAT launches first manufacturer-funded electric car grant to help accelerate electric car adoption following end of UK Government Plug-in Car Grant

Dear Secretary of State for Transport,

The UK Government has set ambitious goals for the sale of electric cars.

However, at Fiat we think more needs to be done to make that plan a reality.

That's why today we've introduced the Flat E-Grant - a £3,000 incentive for anyone who buys a Flat 500e or Flat 500e Convertible.
